FORMS

HEALTH & SAFETY

All prescription medications **MUST** be labeled and in their original containers. Our Health Officer will collect at check in and administer at the appropriate time. Many parents have found it helpful to only send the required amount in the original container. Please do **NOT** send over the counter medications unless they are taken every day. Our Health Officer has over the counter meds for when circumstances arise.

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SUNDAY CHECK IN

Check in begins at 3pm on Sundays. In an effort to make the check in process as smooth and quick as possible, please follow these *new* procedures:

1. You will be greeted on the camp road and directed for parking
2. Bring prescription medications, paperwork, balance due, mail, and care package order forms to check in line at the office porch.
3. There will be 2 lines for check in: with and without medications.
4. Proceed to camp store for shopping and to create store account with cash.
5. Deposit your luggage (after check in) at designated spots in front of Ferguson or head to cabin and set up your campers' bunk.
6. Hugs & prayers good bye. Campers go play in the basketball/gaga zone!

FRIDAY PICK UP

Camper pick up is at 3pm Friday. However, parents are invited and encouraged to come at 2:30 for our closing worship. Pick up procedures:

1. You will be greeted on the camp road. Please present your ID to staff member. Legally, you must be listed on the release form. Receive a Pick Up Pass with camper name on it. You will also receive an early bird registration form for 2020 to fill out & turn in to save money!
2. You will be directed for parking.
3. In the dining hall is closing worship. Give pass to counselor to pick up camper.
4. Turn in early bird registration form, pick up all medications, and receive camp store balances at the office porch.
5. Luggage and lost & found will be waiting outside of Ferguson.

Please note: Mini Camps such as Teddy Bear, Grand Camp, and Pioneer may have different days for check in and pick up. (times are always at 3pm)

CAMP STORE

Store will be open at check in and pick up as well as throughout the week for campers. Items include t-shirts, water bottles, hats, jewelry etc. We ask that campers do not carry money on them.
