

CAMPGROUND RULES

RESERVATIONS:

Registered campers must be 21 years old with valid ID. Individual reservations can be made by calling the camp office. **All group reservations are to be made directly through the campground office.**

Individual reservations: require payment **in full** at the time the reservation is made. You may register and pay upon arrival, but we cannot guarantee a campsite vacancy. We do not guarantee site numbers, but every effort is made to honor requests.

Group reservations: See Group Agreement for reservation payment requirements.

Facility rental reservations: Reservations made through direct contact with campground office. A signed Group Agreement is required.

Rental rates vary at each MAUMC campground. Reservations can be made up to a year in advance for groups and 9 months for individuals.

RESERVATION CHANGES AND/OR CANCELLATIONS:

Individual camper reservations: changes or cancellations may be made by contacting the campground office directly.

- Individual camper reservation cancellations 30+ days prior to arrival will receive a refund minus the service charge of one night's fee per site. Cancellations made less than 30 days prior to arrival will not receive a refund of any kind. Refunds are not given for discomforts of nature.

Campsites may NOT be subleased. In the event the camper loans their unit to another party in their absence, the party using the camping unit must pay the nightly rate and register at the office.

CHECK IN/CHECK OUT TIMES:

Check in is at 3:00 p.m., campsite check out is 1:00 p.m. Campers must check in upon arrival either at the check point located at the camp entrance or the main office. **Due to COVID-19, check out times for Cabins and platform tents at Lake Michigan has been moved to 11:00 am to allow additional cleaning between guest. No check in after 9:00 p.m.**

VISITORS:

- Visiting hours are from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Guests must register and receive your visitor pass. Number of guests may be limited due to COVID-19 regulations.
- Lakeview Family Campground offers non-event day passes for a fee for use of the beach. Call the campground for rates.
- Visitor vehicles must be left in parking lot and may not be parked at the campsite.

GENERAL RULES:

- Due to COVID-19 additional health and safety rules may be in effect and will be posted at the campground.
- Camping is permitted in designated sites only.
- Quiet time is 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- No more than 8 people per camp site, 1 vehicle per site (others can use visitor parking lot). No exception.
- Speed limit through the campground is 5 mph. Caution to be taken at all times.
- ATVs and electric scooters are prohibited with the exception of use by those with special needs.
- Golf carts are acceptable in the campground upon written approval of the Camp Site Director. Only 18 and older are permitted to operate golf carts.
- Radios, generators, or other amplified devices may not be used in a manner that creates excessive noise.
- No alcoholic beverages or smoking in public areas (swim beach, docks, restrooms, showers, cabins, or pavilions).
- By State law, firearms, fireworks and illegal drugs are not permitted within the campground. Discharge of firearms, air guns, slingshots, or arrows are not permitted unless it is a camp sponsored event (i.e. archery).
- Abusive, vulgar or obscene language, actions, or conduct that is annoying and disturbing to others will not be tolerated.
- Do not leave your children under age 12 unattended, including in the bathrooms, showers, and/or on the beach.
- Camper's sinks in the laundry rooms, where available, are not to be used for pets, children, or shampooing hair.

PET FRIENDLY RULES:

- Pets are welcome, limit two per camp site. Must be on a 6-foot leash and under your immediate control at all times.
- Always clean up after your pet. Please carry a waste bag with you at all times.
- Pets are not to be left unattended at your campsite.
- Keep pets from disturbing visitors and interacting with the wildlife
- Pets are prohibited from all public areas including the swim beach, playgrounds, docks, restrooms, showers, cabins, and pavilions.
- Pet runs of any type are prohibited.

FISHING:

- Fish cleaning stations are available at various locations in the campgrounds. Do not dispose of fish or fish cleaning scraps in the dumpsters.
- Fishing is prohibited in swimming areas.

CAMPFIRES:

Campfires are permitted in supplied designated fire rings only. All wood must be purchased and paid for at the campground office (bringing wood from outside the campground to burn is prohibited). Do not leave trash in your fire rings. Do not put multiple fire rings together in an effort to enlarge burning area. Never leave your fire unattended and, prior to leaving, make sure your fire is completely extinguished.

Exception: Lake Michigan Camp requires that you receive approval from camp staff to have a fire on the beach and in the Sugar Bowl area. Lakeview Family Camp does not allow campfires on the beach.

TRASH:

Please seal up your trash in bags and place in the dumpsters located around the campgrounds. **Do not leave your trash out overnight as the animals may help themselves and create a mess.** Trash left at any campsite will result in a \$25 cleaning fee.

DUMP STATION/SEWER:

The dump stations are free to guests. Check with the main office if you need additional services.

ACTIVITIES:

Please check with the main office for a list of activities available to do and rates for recreational equipment rental. A driver's license or state ID are required to rent boats, bikes, paddle boards, and other recreational equipment. A \$10.00 deposit is required and will be returned when all equipment has been returned. When using boats, occupants must wear life jackets correctly at all times. Bikers will be required to wear helmets for their safety. Those using equipment toward the end of the day must return the equipment 30 minutes prior to the office closing.

SWIMMING AREA/BEACH:

NO lifeguard is on duty, so swimming is at your own risk. Swim inside the marked swim area. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at the beach. Please follow the rules posted for Beach and Pavilion Use. Glass containers, bikes, pets, alcohol, and smoking are prohibited on playground, beach area, or swimming area. Please keep glass containers in your campsite. No bikes are allowed in beach area or on docks. Please pick up and dispose of your trash.

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO TERMINATE CAMPERS WHO ARE NON-COMPLIANT WITH CAMP RULES AND WE WILL NOT ISSUE A REFUND TO THOSE ASKED TO LEAVE.
