Welcome to *God's Treasures* 2023! On behalf of our staff, we look forward to having your camper here summer.

The Health History Form **must** be completed and **in my office by May 1st!** This information is very important to the staff as we prepare for camp week.

Incomplete forms will be returned and delay acceptance into the program. PAPERWORK IS NOT TO BE FILLED OUT BY A CAMPER

Registration begins at 9:00 am the first day of camp and continues until 10:15 am. Please plan your arrival accordingly so your camper is here to participate in Opening Worship at 10:30 a.m. Our camp nurses review all paperwork upon the arrival of each camper.

After paperwork is submitted, if *significant* changes occur in your camper physical condition or health, please be in touch with my office so necessary adjustments can be made PRIOR to camper arrival.

Our nurses are on site the entire event and in charge of dispensing all medications. **Our policy is to notify you promptly if any illness or injury occurs with your camper.** As Camp Dean, I will telephone you on any incident, including behavioral issues, that would endanger the camper or others.

God's Treasures is a religious camp experience. Time is spent in Bible activities, music, worship, crafts and recreation. There is a rest period each day. The staff looks forward to sharing God's love with everyone. We trust it will be a week of fun, friendship and new experiences for all.

We'll conclude camp with our *Closing Worship*. We'll gather in Poole Chapel for a 10:00 am time of worship and praise. *This is an important event for our campers and it's important for caregivers to be here.* However, if your schedule prevents this please remember –

ALL CAMPERS MUST BE PICKED UP NO LATER THAN 11:00 am
